Nov 7th, 2010 : Day 1: Overnight Flight

Travel overnight to Portugal, one of Europe's most hospitable countries. Here you can enjoy a superb climate, historic sites, and beautiful scenery.

Nov 8th, 2010 : Day 2: Lisbon, Portugal

Your tour begins in Lisbon upon your arrival. On your way to the hotel enjoy a quick overview of the city. This evening is yours to explore.

Nov 9th, 2010 : Day 3: Lisbon - Fatima, Portugal -

This morning, enjoy a city tour of Lisbon highlighting the Moorish Alfama Quarter. See the 16th century Jeronimo's Monastery and the Monument to the Discoveries, which honors intrepid Portuguese explorers and their patrons. The impressive Belem Tower with its carved rope and balconies stands watch where great navigators once set forth. Later today, enjoy leisure time in Estoril. Stroll its narrow cobblestone streets, walk the wide beach promenade or shop for ceramics, lace, filigree, hand woven works and tapestries. Continue on to Fatima, Portugal. *Today breakfast & dinner will be included.*

Nov 10th, 2010 : Day 4: Fatima

Today exploring the Basilica to see the Tombs of Francisco and Jacinta and its grounds. ★ **Travel to Aljustrel, where the children lived, and the Valinhos, where Our Lady appeared after the**

children's return from prison.★ This afternoon, travel to one of the most picturesque spots in all of Portugal, the coastal village of Nazare. Witness the architectural splendor of the massive Alcobaca Monastery. This evening, enjoy time for independent exploration *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Nov 11th, 2010 : Day 5: Fatima - Burgos, Spain

★ **LANGUAGE DISCOVERY:** Today, your Tour Manager will help you discover the origin and history of the language(s) you will experience on your tour along with key words and phrases that will help you communicate with the locals.★ Travel east to Burgos, known as the cradle of the Castile region. The town stands on the banks of the Rio Arlazon with the slender, elegant spires of its famous cathedral rising into the sky. Upon arrival, visit the Cathedral of Burgos, the third largest church in Spain. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Nov 12th, 2010 : Day 6: Burgos - Lourdes, France

Today travel northeast through the Pyrenees to Lourdes. This is where the Virgin Mary appeared in the Grotto of Massabielle to the poor shepherd girl, Bernadette, a total of 18 times between February 11 - July 16, 1858. This little market town has been a pilgrimage site of world renown ever since. Tonight enjoy a local dinner. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Nov 13th, 2010: Day 7: Lourdes

★ **Enjoy a walking tour of Lourdes, visiting the places associated with the life of St. Bernadette: the Holy Hill, the local mill, the parish church and the "Cachot", the chapel where she received Holy Communion.**★ Later, at leisure, explore the town's rich historical and natural heritage and be submerged in the atmosphere that reigned during the apparitions and the spirit of brotherhood that is still present today. *Today breakfast, lunch and dinner will be included.*

Nov 14th, 2010: Day 8: Lourdes - Carcassone - Barcelona, Spain

Today you're travelling through southern France's Pyrenees Mountains to Carcassone. Enjoy some leisure time to explore this beautiful, historic town and its medieval atmosphere. Later, cross back into Spain and travel to fascinating Barcelona, one of Europe's most popular cities. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Nov 15th, 2010: Day 9: Barcelona

★Get an in-depth look at Barcelona with a tour that showcases Las Ramblas Boulevard, Columbus Monument, Parc Montjuic,

Mila House and Parc Guell.★ Your tour concludes with a viewing of Antonio Gaudi's masterpiece, "La Sagrada Familia." The afternoon is at leisure for independent exploration or you to enjoy the city. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a dinner celebrating the end of a memorable tour. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Nov 16th, 2010: Day 10: Barcelona - Tour Ends

Burgos...Land of Cathedrals

Burgos was founded in 884 and its historical heritage is immediately evident. Admittedly, its main sights are ecclesiastical, most notably the cathedral itself, but it is an atmospheric place and has a rare grandeur and medieval northern Castilian ambience.

The Cathedral of Burgos, completed in 1222, is among the most admired of its kind worldwide. Especially remarkable are its portal, the "Puerta del Sarmental," considered the best example of Gothic sculpture of its century. The Cathedral of Burgos is modeled after the French cathedral of Bourges and reflects the Gothic style made popular in Spain by the Cistercian Order.

The Monasterio de las Huelgas, with its Gothic chapterhouse of unique value and its Romanesque cloister, is considered one of the most important monuments in Spain. It was founded in 1187 by Alfonso VIII whose tomb, alongside those of other members of the Spanish royal family, can be visited inside.

After sightseeing, you may want to try out Burgos' exquisite cuisine. The most famous food of Burgos is the fresh cheese with slight goat-milk-flavor, called "Queso de Burgos."
